

2008 Speed Handicapper® v5.0 Track Constants™
Download and Installation Instructions
(We suggest you print these instructions for reference.)

Downloading:

You will receive an email from Desert Sea Publishing Co. with a link to the PayLoadz website for a download that will be valid for 48 hours. If you need additional time or a fresh download of the same file any time in the future, just let us know and we will send a new link.

Follow the instructions for the download from Desert Sea Publishing Co. (Please add us to your "Safe Senders List." to ensure you receive all updates and important messages.)

We recommend creating a new folder on your computer to store the downloaded file.

Windows Vista® may insist that you download to your "Desktop" as the file location without an option. If this happens, you can move the file to another folder after the download.

Click "Save" (not "Run") when the option appears, and save the file to the folder you have created. This way you will have it stored if you need it in the future.

Copying to the Program Files Folder:

Close all other windows and open the folder where you saved the file.

Click or double-click on the Normal.exe file and it will open a dialog window.

Windows® XP and earlier:

Use the "Browse" button to navigate to the "C:\Program Files\Speed Handicapper v5.0" folder and then click "Extract." If it asks if you want to overwrite the existing file click "Yes." You're done. (Except to double-check, below.)

Windows® Vista:

Windows Vista® blocks access to the Program Files Folder without a warning notice, so the best way to be sure your Track Constants™ are updated is to manually copy and replace the file.

Use the "Browse" button to navigate to the **same** folder where you put the Normal.exe file, and then click "Extract."

This creates a new file named "Normal.csv." Right-click on the Normal.csv file and select "Copy."

Next, no matter how much Windows Vista® complains and nags, navigate to "**C:\Program Files\Speed Handicapper v5.0,**" right-click and select "Paste." When it asks if you want to overwrite the existing file, click "Yes."

Double-Check:

Navigate to "**C:\Program Files\Speed Handicapper v5.0,**" and check the date of the "Normal.csv" file to ensure it is dated April, 2008 or later. If it is any date prior to April, 2008 the copy or extraction procedure did not succeed and you should review the steps above.
